## Patterns to 100 !

Goal: Find patterns in a 100 chart.

## You will need:

- Print a 100 chart or make your own!
- Crayons, color pencils, or markers (3 different colors)


## What to do:

- Before starting, think about which group of numbers will have the most boxes colored: 2 s , 5 s , or 10s.
- Using color 1, color the top third of each box containing a number you say when counting by 2 s .
- Using color 2, color the middle of the box containing a number you say when counting by 5 s .
- Using color 3, color the bottom third of the box containing a number you say when counting by 10s.


## To think about:

- What patterns do you notice when counting by 2 s , 5 s , or 10 s?
- What do you notice about the numbers that were colored only once? twice? three times? What do they have in common? Why do you think that is?
