Leaf Match Clues

This is an activity for two or more players.

Goal: To compare the attributes of leaves

You will need:

· An assortment of many different types of leaves

How to play:

- Place a pile of leaves in front of the players.
- Each player selects one leaf from the pile to use at the start of the game.
- Take turns reading the leaf clues. The clues tell the players what type of leaf they should look for in the pile and pick next. For example, a clue might say, take a leaf that is smaller. This means the players would all remove a leaf from the pile that is smaller than the leaf they started with.
- If the player can't find a leaf that matches the description, they wait for the next clue.
- At the end of each clue, the player selects the leaf they will use for the next clue. It may be their original leaf or the new leaf that they pulled from the pile.
- The game ends when all of the leaves have been removed from the pile.
