## Animal Faces

Goal: Create animal faces out of shapes.

## You will need:

- Paper plates or construction paper
- Glue sticks
- Scissors


## What to Do:

- Choose a favorite animal. What shapes do you see in the animal's face?
- Make the animal's face with at least three different shapes. What shapes will you use for the eyes, ears, mouth, snout, nose, horns, etc.?
- Arrange the shapes on construction paper or a paper plate.
- Layer and overlap the shapes.
- Glue as you go!


## More to Do:



- Create an animal face. Work with a partner and take turns placing one shape at a time on a paper plate or piece of construction paper. Neither person should say what animal they have in mind. Take no more than 6 turns each. What does the animal look like?
- Create an animal face, but limit the number of times you can use a specific shape. For example, a circle can only be used twice, a square can only be used once, etc.
