Find that Shape

Goal: Recognize shapes

You will need:


- Construction paper
- Markers
- Tape or glue
- A large piece of paper
- Wall or easel

What to do:

- Draw squares, rectangles, triangles, hearts, circles, and rhombuses on the large piece of paper. Make sure the shapes are spaced out and randomly placed. Draw each shape at least 5 times.
- Use the construction paper to cut out each of the shapes as many times as you drew them.
- Prompt your child to find all of the circles on the large piece of paper and tape (or glue) the corresponding cut out shape on top.
- Pick another shape that is drawn on the page. Ask your child to find them and tape the cut-out shape on top.

Alternatives:

- Circle the shapes instead of taping cut outs.
- Use foam shapes with sticky backs to place on top of the corresponding shapes.
- Color each of the different shapes with its own color. For example, color all of the circles red.
