## Red, Yellow, Blue

Goal: Follow directions to the next dot!

## You will need:

- Construction Paper ( $5 x$ red, $5 x$ yellow, $5 x$ blue)
- Cut out (template attached):
- 5 Red Dots
- 5 Yellow Dots
- 5 Blue Dots
- Open Area

- Children playing should have a knowledge of what a pattern is


## How to play:

- 2 to 5 children can play.
- Spread out the 15 dots across the open area.
- Pick one child to be the person in charge of the round. Once picked, they will make a color pattern with the three colors and write it down.
- After the pattern is chosen, the child who is in charge calls out the first color in their pattern and the other children will find that color dot (ex: go to a yellow dot). Only one child can stand on a single dot.
- They will then call out the next color in their pattern. They will repeat their pattern, until another player figures out the pattern and is able to recall what it is correctly. This child is now in charge of the next round.
- The next round is started by the player making a new patten and calling out the first color.
- Remind children while playing they are trying to figure out the pattern.


## To think about:

- What if each color in the pattern has a movement along with it? For example, jump three times on yellow, snap your fingers on blue, etc.
- The players will need to recall the instruction and the pattern to become in charge.
