

Plus 1 Brown Fish Makes...

This is a game for two or three players.

Goal: To add small groups of fish together.

You will need:

- Fish cards
- Number Cards
- Brown fish cards
- Five fish markers

Game setup:

- Spread all of the fish cards on a flat surface, fish side up. This group of fish is called the fish pond. Stack the number cards in a pile, number side down. Stack the brown fish cards in a separate pile, fish side down.

How to play:

- Each player takes one number card from the stack. The person with the biggest number goes first.
- On each player's turn, a number card is taken from the pile and placed face side up in front of the player. This card tells how many fish cards to remove from the fish pond. Next the player draws a brown fish card. The player adds the brown fish to the fish removed from the fish pond. The player announces the number of fish they have once the brown fish are added to the fish from the fish pond.
- Then it's the next player's turn.
- At the end of each round, the player who has the most fish gets a fish marker. All players return their fish to the pond and start another round.
- Play five rounds. The person who has with the most fish markers at the end of the five rounds wins the game.
